**Events Included:** Three events with five races scheduled.

- New York Yacht Club's 158<sup>th</sup> Annual Regatta presented by Rolex on June 9-10 in Newport, Rhode Island. The first race each day counts in the Onion Patch Series scoring.
- The Newport Bermuda Race® organized by The Cruising Club of America and the Royal Bermuda Yacht Club starting June 15. This offshore classic is weighted at 1.25 versus 1.0 for the other races.
- Royal Bermuda Yacht Club's Anniversary Regatta on June 22 with one windward-leeward race in Bermuda's Great Sound and a "Tour of Bermuda" race finishing in Hamilton Harbour.

**Individual or Team Entry:** Boats all enter individually to compete for the Henry B. duPont Trophy and are encouraged to form three-boat teams to race for both the Onion Patch Trophy and the Henry B. duPont Trophy.
